Our “Nierspiraten” kindergarten is located on the outskirts of Goch in the direction of Pfalzdorf. We are a four-group daycare center and look after 85 children aged 3-6 years under the aspect of inclusion. Our multifunctional team consists of educators, special educators, child care workers, a social worker, a PIA trainee and a language specialist.

Care Options:

We offer you various options for a care place for your child. This can be booked for 25 hours, 35 hours and 45 hours within our opening hours. Parents can arrange the 35-hour care flexibly. Please make an appointment or call, where we will be happy to explain these options to you.

Movement- & plusKITA:

We are a certified movement kindergarten (co-operation partner is the DLRG). This means that children are encouraged and supported in their development in terms of movement and body awareness.

We are a plusKITA: The aim of the plusKITA is to improve the educational opportunities of children with difficult starting conditions (children from low-income families, with a migration background, with language difficulties) through targeted encouragement and support. Educational disadvantages are reduced by individually promoting the children's potential. Our team includes a language specialist to support this.
